Each topic is supported by hands-on exercises that are based on real-life examples designed to provide the participant with the knowledge necessary to plan for a QC installation and maintain an ongoing QC server.

The goal of the workshop is to enable participants to understand both the role of a QC Site Administrator, and to become familiar with the many QC configuration options that are available. Correct configuration of the Quality Center server will ensure that QC performs as expected and supports the overall QC site initiative.
